

# Questions and Answers!

## 12<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL REVENGE OF MONTEZUMA 2012

Q. Do you have any specific range rules other than SASS rules?

A) Yes,

1. A live round over the berm is a Match DQ at anytime during the main match or side matches.

2. I have been asked about Hip shooting, or “Out Law” It is not recommended at our range. We have an airport just over the hill, and a round over the berm, may reach that far. That is why we discourage it. We could be at risk of losing our range. Please, just don't. Shotgun will be warned once, then penalties will apply, rifle or pistol .....Minor Safety for 1<sup>st</sup> time, Stage DQ 2<sup>nd</sup> time.

3. This is a muzzle up range.

3. Long guns must have their actions open while being carried or in a gun cart. The only exception is if they are in scabbards, socks or enclosed gun carts.

Q. What about Dogs.

A) We love dogs. I have a dog..... A little yappin' teeth baring, over protected spoiled brat that loves chocolate. But....You must keep your dog on a leash and pick up their poo! They are not allowed in the shooting area during the match or under the food area during lunch.

Q. Do you have a DQ forward rule.

A) No, *except for a live round over the berm*, the side matches, main match, and the Sunday afternoon team shoot are all in the NO DQ FORWARD RULE.

Q. I need to ship items to this area, as I can't bring it all with me, is there someone that is willing to accept shipments?

A) Yes, you may have any item shipped to the address on the application. Please have shipper put (Your Alias) and then in "care of" Jeff Stewart. Give us a quick email to let us know it's coming, and we'll send one right back as soon as it arrives. Email [target7@beyondbb.com](mailto:target7@beyondbb.com)

Packages are not opened unless you want it checked for damage.

Q. Do you have electricity at the camp.

A) No, if you want electricity, you must bring a generator. Please turn off generators by 10:30 pm and not on again until 6 am or later.

Q. Do you have running water and indoor bathrooms?

A) No, but we do have porta potties, we do have a water Hydrant where you are welcome to fill your bottles (Good Colorado Drinking water. And we do have campers down there with hot water if you need it. We try to make it as comfortable as possible, especially for the ladies.

If you need ANYTHING, we can get it for you as far as personal hygiene goes. Contact Stumble Leena, Shotgun Shell or Cripple Creek Sue at the range.

Q. Do you have loaner gun carts?

A) Yes, we have a few that we set out at no charge if you

need one. If you are coming from out of town or country, we try to posse so that you can share if needed. Let us know if you need a gun cart and how many will be sharing it.

Q. Can you leave your gun carts at the range?

A) Yes, you may leave them at the main trailer, in the cabin, or at Parrot City.

Q. Are lunches served at the shoot.

A) Yes, don't know what yet, but we'll get you fed.

Q. Do you have brassers.

A) We try to have a brassers for every posse, but that is just a matter of finding the kids that will do it.

Q. Do the side matches cost?

A) The 4 Wheeler side match is \$10, Clays is \$15 and the rest are free.

Q. What kind of awards do you have and how far do you go down?

A) We have an award for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>. We also recognize Overall Man and Overall Woman. Clean Match awards. (That's no misses, procedurals or safeties)

Q. What kind of targets do you have?

A) Well.....let me see....we have big and little, up close and far away, some movement, some stand and deliver, we have two stars from hell as we call them. Most shotgun are knockdowns, and may be re-engaged if missed. Bonus targets. We sometimes

have things that you have to do. Like throw a rock, carry an egg, shoot a slingshot. Carry a baby to a crib. Throw a spear. Carry a ball and chain..... Every shoot is different. So hard to tell what Piedra will come up with. Some are off the clock some are on, depending on the difficulty.

Q. How far away is the Range from Town?

A) 3 miles.

Q. What is this Mounted 4-Wheeler shoot about?

A) You will be shooting a mounted Cowboy or Cowgirls 45's with blanks from the back of a 4-wheeler that is driven by one of the members. You will shoot at balloons just like the mounted shooters do on horseback. It is a hoot! You **MUST** leave your guns and ammo belts at home. They are not allowed in the mounted area. All guns and ammo will be provided by the Revengers of Montezuma Mounted Club.

Q. Some motels have a problem with or I just don't feel safe leaving my guns in my room. Do you have a safe area?

A) Yes, we have a **BIG** safe at the Stagecoach Trading Post. If you wish to store your guns there over night contact Chuck Martin or Robin Martin at 970-565-2523.

Q. How does your club feel about Alcoholic beverages at the Range?

A) No alcoholic beverages until all guns are put away and range is cold.

Q. What about smoking?

A) You may smoke, but we would like you to not throw your butt on the ground. Stumble Leena goes around after the shoot and picks them all up, so save her a little back work!

Q. What does your range look like, is it uphill or smooth. Gravel?

A) Our range is in the dirt. We have a gravel drive, but the range itself has grass, weeds and dirt. So sometimes brassing can be hard. You might not get all your brass back, but we do try. It will be groomed and ready to go for the Revenge. Pictures of our range will be in the gallery sometime in January. We have 5 berms, Berm 1 has a cabin and a hay barn. Berm 2 is where our shed is, and wagon. Berm 3 is our Parrot City and Outhouse. Berm 4 is the Fort and Corral, and Berm 5 is the Pond. We shoot 2 stages in each berm before moving to the next.

Camping and parking is on flat ground and an easy stroll to the shooting range. We have room for about 15 campers. Horse trailers will be parked up on top and ride down. Overflow of campers will park on top across from the Mounted Campers..

Q. What about Vendors?

A) Vendors are welcome and there is no charge. If you wish to donate you may, but not necessary. If you wish to Vend at the Revenge, give me an email at [target7@beyondbb.com](mailto:target7@beyondbb.com) Vendors are welcome to pre-shoot the match on Thursday before the main match or shoot through on Saturday.

Q. How early may I come?

A) Range will be open at 2:00 pm on Wednesday before the shoot. If you need to come earlier, give me an email at [target7@beyondbb.com](mailto:target7@beyondbb.com) and we'll make sure the gate is open.

Q. How are your stages set up?

A) As stated above somewhere...we shoot 2 stages in each berm. We have 5 posses (up to 20 shooters) shooting in each berm, 2 stages each.

Friday evening is set aside for our Black Powder Shoot, Our Theatrical Play and the Revengers Poker Night. Saturday night is our banquet and we have the Long Range and Side match awards. Sunday is the Main Match awards. Thursday is spent running the pre-shooters through all 10 stages and painting targets and getting last minute details worked out.

Q. Do you recognize the side match awards between men and women?

A) No

Q. Do you have shooter prizes for each participant?

A) We have had in the past, but each year it is getting harder and harder. We decided that if we get enough we'll do it, it not..... what we do get will be used at the Banquet Dinner. Your dinner ticket in your shooter packet will be your door prize ticket. So don't forget it.

Q. What does sponsorship entail?

A) If you sponsor a stage, your name is put on the bottom of the stage that you sponsored in the Shooters book. The sponsor donations are broke down into \$50, \$100, or \$200 A full stage is \$200. Otherwise you will be sharing it with another sponsor. Up to 4 with a \$50 donation.

To be a MATCH Sponsor, you must provide something of equal value to all participants, i.e.: Discount on items you provide a service for.

To be a GIFT sponsor, provide one or more gifts and your name, business will be added to the shooters book.
